#### A Patient's Bill of Rights

- 1 You have the right to be treated with consideration and respect.
2. You have the right to full information from your physician or counsellor, spoken in a way that you can understand.
3. You have the right to all the facts before agreeing to any procedure or treatment. You have the right to know the name of the person doing the treatment.
4. You have the right to refuse treatment.
5. You have the right to confidentiality.
6. You have the right to expect medical and counselling services.
7. You have the right to decide whether or not to be used for research or teaching purposes.
8. You have the right to an adequate standard of care.
9. You have the right to know what physicians or counsellors are available and at what times.
10. You have the right to know what Teen Health Centre rules apply to your behaviour as a patient.
